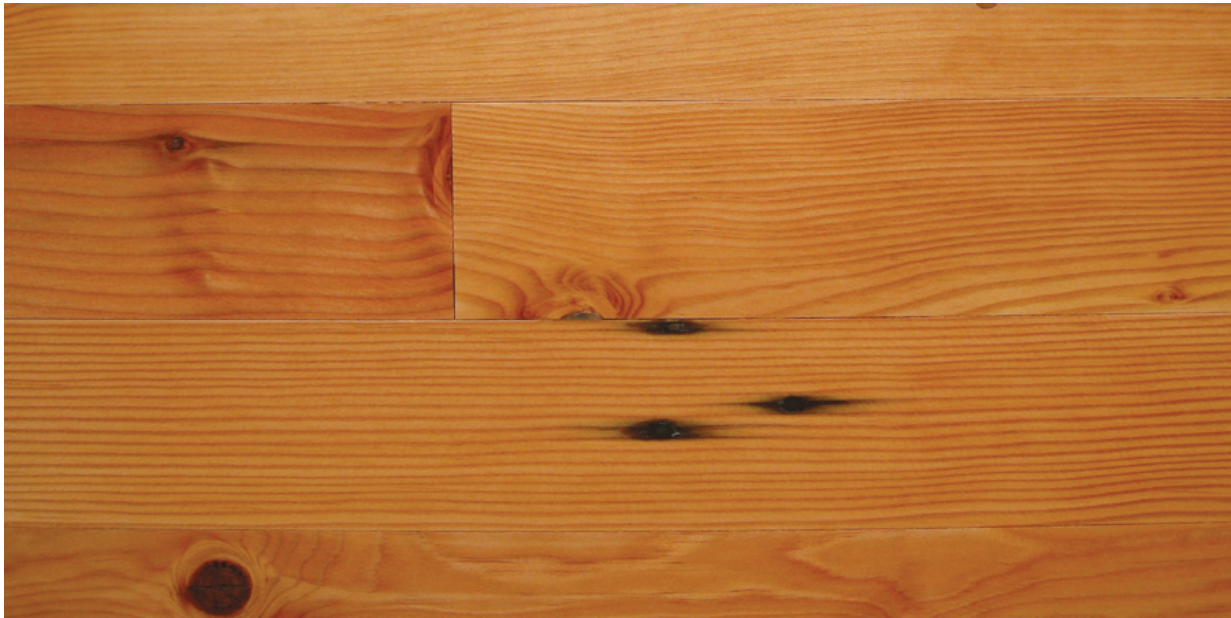


old growth douglas fir – mixed grain

If you are looking to match a home's existing fir floors we've got you covered; even our milling pattern was designed to mimic the classic Old Portland bungalow's fir floor. If you're looking for flooring with character we have fir with many nail holes and oxide stains, or if you're looking for a rustic look we can supply the weathered, original beam face that is precision milled to install beautifully. And for something truly unique our fir paneling is available with a WindWorn™ texture. Reminiscent of barn wood worn down by the elements, WindWorn finish is an extremely affordable and distinctive way to use reclaimed wood.

description	Classic douglas fir with exceptionally tight mixed grain and an occasional nail hole to let you know it is reclaimed. Available in multiple widths or mix widths to create additional interest.
source	Old growth beams reclaimed from Pacific Northwest building deconstruction and remodeling.
net dimensions	thickness: ¾" face width: 3¼", 5", 7" or mix widths lengths: 4-10'
millwork	Tongue & groove, square edge, mill run (end cut at time of installation).
species	<i>Pseudotsuga menziesii</i>
hardness	660-710 (Janka scale).
grade	All material is C&Btr grade and kiln dried.
character	Color: Rich honey color that subtly darkens over time. This natural process, called patina, will add to the beauty and character of your wood. Mixed Grain flooring & paneling contains very tight mixed grain with few nail holes, black oxide staining, heartwood and sapwood, occasional tight knots, minor pitch pockets and very infrequent non-structural checks up to 1/16".
finish	Unfinished unless specified (factory finish available for all paneling except Rustic face). Paneling available with WindWorn™ textured wood finish (reminiscent of barn wood worn down by the elements), see WindWorn specification sheet for details.
shipping	All material is FOB Portland or Seattle, please call for details (factory finished FOB Seattle). We can coordinate local or national delivery. Material is bundle packaged and bundles are packed into units 4' wide x up to 10' long (most 6' or less). Estimated ship weight: 2½ pounds per square foot.
installation	Store, handle and install per National Wood Flooring Association (NWFA) guidelines available at viridianwood.com.
