And once cut down life gets even rougher, enduring grueling conditions of heavy cargoes and harsh seas as crating material on ships. So you can imagine the tragedy of this lumber making the journey all the way to America just to be discarded. We had to do something, so we rescued this stunning wood and created our Siberian Spruce paneling. Its rustic character hints of its rough-and-tumble past, with its inner beauty now exposed and preserved for generations of enjoyment.

Siberian Spruce paneling is very flexible and customizable: we have a wide range of thicknesses and we are able to mill to virtually any profile with short lead times.

description

Subarctic mix of Russian spruce and pine. This product is highly customizable, from a vintage weathered look to a fresh modern look. Please call with your project ideas and we will make them a reality.

source

Locally reclaimed in Portland, Oregon from shipping crates. Due to the difficulty in reclaiming the material the wood was previously discarded or burned. Viridian pioneered a process to divert the material from landfills, separate the highest quality wood and give it new life in our flooring and paneling.

dimensions

thickness: 5/8" or 3/4" face width: 3" lengths: 4' – 8'+

millwork

Tongue & groove, square edge, mill run (end cut at time of installation). Custom profiles (v-groove, microbevel, etc) available.

species

picea obovata, *picea spp.*, *pinus spp.*

hardness

460 (Janka scale).

character

Color: Light cream, browns and grays, with occasional amber pitch streaks. Material accepts stains very uniformly.

May contain: unlimited grain combinations including flat, quarter, rift, and plain sawn; heartwood and sapwood; minor oxide and mineral staining from prior use; tight knots, very few nail holes; small non-structural checks.

finish

Unfinished unless specified (factory finish available).

WindWorn™ textured wood finish (reminiscent of barn wood worn down by the elements) available, see WindWorn specification sheet for details.

shipping

All material is FOB Portland.

We can coordinate local or national delivery.

Material is bundle packaged and bundles are packed into units 4' wide x up to 12' long (most 8' or less).

Estimated ship weight: 2¼ pounds per square foot (at ¾" thick)

installation

Store, handle and install per Architectural Woodwork Standards (AWS).
