Its blond-tan palette with occasional veins of brown and peach provide a light, fresh look that can brighten a traditional space or add warmth to a modern interior. Distinctive iridescent rays and occasional dark veins of spalting give European Beech a sophisticated, subtle texture. Viridian's European Beech is reclaimed in Portland from global shipping crates used to import windmills and other steel products from Europe. The wood is extremely durable, perfect for commercial or residential use.

The subtle grain pattern of European Beech consists of mellow golds, tans and peaches. Black veining in some boards (spalting) creates a marbled look, and small iridescent figuring adds another level of depth to this incredibly durable wood.

source

Locally reclaimed in Portland, Oregon from shipping crates used to import windmills and other steel products. Due to the difficulty in reclaiming the material the wood was previously discarded or burned. Viridian pioneered a process to divert the material from landfills, separate the highest quality wood and give it new life in our european beech tabletops.
