Reclaimed from cargo shipping crates from Port of Portland, Viridian's Fishtail Oak is a gorgeous, high-quality exotic oak species with many variations of chocolate, honey and cinnamon with tinges of burgundy. The grain pattern is a real showstopper. Like the scales of a fish, iridescent copper flecks and gorgeous figure give this oak a lively feeling while maintaining a consistent look overall. Its quarter sawn appearance and punctuations of charcoal marbling provide a rich look that can warm a modern space or blend beautifully with traditional environments. Our reclaimed oak is not only stunning, it is also well suited to commercial and residential applications and it is built to last a lifetime.

### description

Like the scales of a fish, iridescent copper flecks and gorgeous figure give this oak a lively feeling while maintaining a consistent look overall. Its quarter sawn appearance and punctuations of charcoal marbling make it a unique conversation piece and is easy to integrate into any style of room.

### source

Locally reclaimed in Portland, Oregon from exotic hardwood shipping crates. Due to the difficulty in reclaiming the material the wood was previously discarded or burned. Viridian pioneered a process to divert the material from landfills, separate the highest quality wood and give it new life in our fishtail oak flooring.

*Quercus spp.* (Mempening)

### hardness

1450 (Janka scale). Suitable for commercial applications.

### character

**Color:** Fishtail Oak comes from a consistent species, however, the combination of heartwood and sapwood creates subtle variations of browns, tans and burgundy along with charcoal marbling and the iridescent figuring that gives it its name.

**May contain:** unlimited grain combinations including flat, quarter, rift, and plain sawn; heartwood and sapwood; minor oxide and mineral staining from prior use; spalting; very infrequent tight knots, nail holes and few insect holes (all material is kiln dried); infrequent non-structural checks up to 1/16".

### finish

Factory applied multi-coat, low VOC Polyurethane.

### shipping

All material is FOB Portland.  
We can coordinate local or national delivery.  
Estimated ship weight: 7 pounds per square foot (standard 1½" thickness)
