At the turn of the century California's rapidly expanding wine industry chose the highest grade old growth redwood for making their wine casks. Redwood's dense, straight grain was preferred by winemakers because, unlike oak, it does not add flavor to the wines and it is incredibly long lasting. They do not make tight grain Redwood like this anymore, period. It's warm, rich color with just a hint of rose staining from its prior use creates some of the most rare and exquisite siding and paneling in the world. Its vintage character and incredible history will be enjoyed for many more generations in our gorgeous paneling.

Dismantled wine tank carefully inventoried and preserved for future use.

description

Rich, classic old growth California Redwood. Consistent flat grain with just a hint of rose staining from the winemaking process. You can actually smell a faint hint of wine in the wood (which is not noticeable in a room once installed / finished). This material is suitable for indoor or outdoor application.

source

Coast redwood reclaimed from large wine tanks. Over the years wineries have transitioned to larger stainless steel tanks; as the redwood tanks are dismantled we rescue this amazing wood it and give it new life as paneling and veneer products.

dimensions

thickness: 3/8" up to 3/4" face width: 4 1/2" lengths: random 4' – 8' common (up to 12')

millwork

Tongue & groove, mill run (end cut at installation). We can mill to any custom profile including lap, v-groove, & microbevel.

character

Color: Warm, rich red characteristic of all redwood.

May contain: minor mineral staining from prior use; very rare dowel holes and small non-structural checks.

finish

Unfinished unless specified (factory finish available).

shipping

All material is FOB Portland unless otherwise stated.

Material is bundle packaged and bundles are packed into units 4' wide x up to 12' long.

Estimated ship weight: 2 pounds per square foot (at 3/4" thick)
