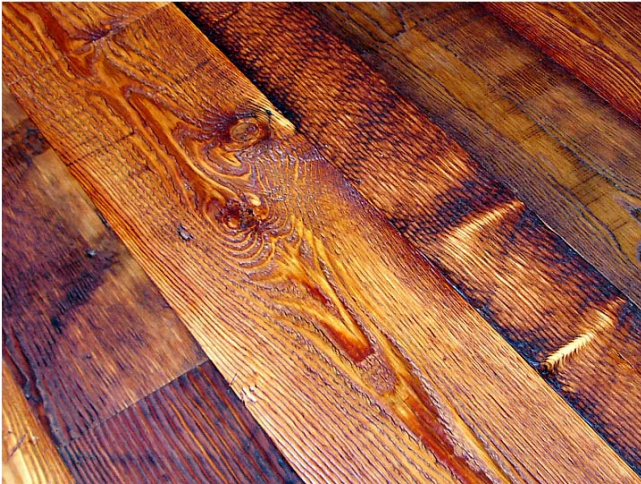

### description

Classic douglas fir with lots of character from its prior life as a structural beam including saw marks, raised grain, and even some nail holes and oxide staining. All of it is exceptionally tight grain; even mixed grain boards are very tight with few knots. Mixed widths and mixed lengths add additional interest.

### source

Old growth beams reclaimed from Pacific Northwest building deconstruction and remodeling.

### net dimensions

thickness: ¾"      face width: Net 4", 6" or 8"      lengths: 4-10'

### millwork

Tongue & groove, square edge, mill run (end cut at time of installation).

### species

*Pseudotsuga menziesii*

### hardness

660-710 (Janka scale).

### grade

All material is C&Btr grade and kiln dried.

### character

**Color:** Dark honey patina punctuated with deep browns and blacks from the woods' prior use

**Rustic (original beam face) flooring & paneling** contains slightly uneven surfaces, saw marks and minor indentations from its prior use; the material arrives nylon brushed to remove catches but retain original character. It will contain some nail holes, black oxide staining, heartwood and sapwood, occasional tight knots, minor pitch pockets and infrequent non-structural checks up to 1/16".

### finish

Unfinished unless specified.

### shipping

All material is FOB Portland or Seattle, please call for details (factory finished FOB Seattle).  
We can coordinate local or national delivery.  
Material is bundle packaged and bundles are packed into units 4' wide x up to 10' long (most 6' or less).  
Estimated ship weight: 2½ pounds per square foot.
